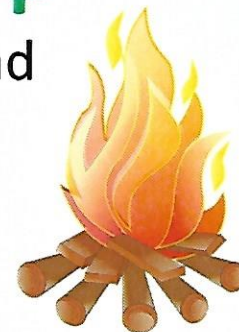


# Sunny Hills 4-H Camp
