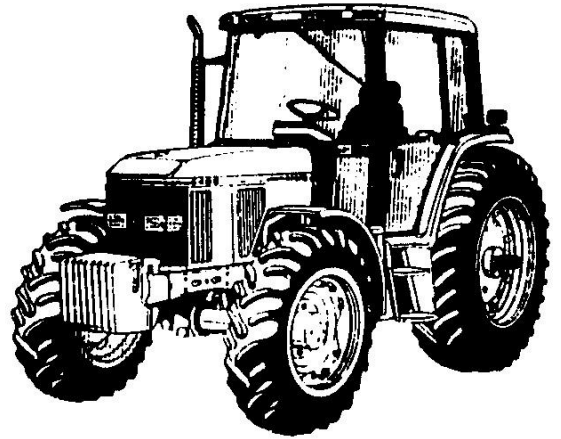


# Tractor Safety

## ***Who should attend:***

14 and 15 year olds planning to do farm work for someone other than a parent or guardian, must take a tractor safety course following the U.S. Department of Labor requirements before being employed for certain hazardous farm tasks. This includes operating a tractor over 20 horsepower.
