

## **4-H Fair Book Updates**

Some changes have been made this year to the 4-H Fair Book. Some of the changes made include new project areas, updated project descriptions and requirements, and several rule updates/changes. Outlined below are some of the changes in more detail. Please take time and read the fair rules and information relevant to projects you plan on entering. ### **Rule Changes**

- Shopping In Style will require a display and display judging will be exempt from consultative judging requirements. 4-Her's will still be allowed to be at judging if they desire.
- Failure to turn in Fashion Revue Scripts & Photos will result in the 4-Her not being judged in the Fashion Revue. They are still allowed to model, but will receive no ribbon placing.

### **Project Updates**

- Read 4-H now has its own category in the 4-H Fair. Please note that all classes are ineligible to go onto the State Fair at this time.
- Exhibitors may enter up to 2 dairy goats. This can be 2 does, 2 wethers, or 1 of each.
