



Read 4-H Task List

Each year a theme will be established for Read 4-H. 4-Her's will read books of their choosing, or from our suggested book list, and complete tasks to earn a reward at the end of the year. Rewards will vary each year, but they may include a trip, event, or special prize which will be announced by the Extension Office. The Read 4-H program will run from December 1st until July 31st. All tasks must be completed in that time to count towards the yearly reward. Rewards will be given in August or September depending on scheduling. 4-Her's must complete 6 out of 10 potential tasks to receive their end of the year reward.

- Submit 1 Book Review every month of the program
- Go to your local library and check out a book to read for Read 4-H. Once you've read the book, please have the Librarian sign the designated form and submit it to the Extension Office.
- Visit a library not in the town (or closest town) you live in. Please have a Librarian's signature on the designated form and submit it to the Extension Office

Participate in 4-H Club Days with a reading related project. Examples include, dramatic reading from a book, illustrated talked based on book, perform a special music related to the theme of the book or corresponding movie, etc...

- o Each Club Day project related to reading will count as 1 task completed with a maximum of 2 tasks.
